

The finest proofing results will be achieved with Vandercook replacement inking rollers since they are manufactured to our specifications which have been established through our close relationship with photoengravers, typographers and printers for over 50 years. Type A form rollers are generally recommended for printers, typesetters and newspapers, type B on photoengraver's test presses and electric galley proof presses.

Double-coated on one side, Vandercook Gold-Tone Repro Paper will produce proofs with hairline definition, superior opacity, and without halations. Vandercook Satin-Tone Repro Paper is coated on both sides, and is excellent for in-plant use. Vandercook Trans-Tone Repro Paper has a special coating which provides an exceptional blue-white surface for repro proofs, and is translucent to permit contacting direct to film. Also available is 3M Scotchprint Brand Printing Stock with a smooth, grainless surface highly receptive to ink.

Three repro inks—Fast-Dry is formulated mainly for repro proofing of live copy and sets up for immediate handling; Heat-Set proofs can be used after forced drying; Conversion gives top results on Scotchprint and acetate, as well as repro papers and will not be affected by rubber cement. Also Engraver's Black Ink and Galley Black Ink.






to check form roller bearing surface.




Checking the thickness and uniformity of Vandercook Tympan with a Vandercook gauge which simulates printing pressures.
